- Kettle for hot water (percolator or coffee press available)
- Salt & pepper
- Scrubie and Dr Bronner's Soap
- Hand towels
- Vinyl tablecloth
 - ✓ Rates are for groups up to 4. Rates for more dependent on group size. Larger pots, pans and kettles are available for larger groups.
 - ✓ Camp Stoves are rented separately.
 - ✓ The cooking equipment in the KB is NOT designed for use on an open wood or charcoal fire. Cast Iron equipment is available for such use.
 - ✓ Back-country cook kits can be assembled. Rates dependent on contents.
